## **Warrenton Septic Assistance Program**

## **APPLICATION**



Awarded \$912,390 from the Virginia Department of Environmental Quality's American Rescue Plan Act (ARPA) funding, this grant will enable qualified property owners within the Town of Warrenton (Town) limits to remove their septic system and connect to the public sewer, improving environmental health and water quality. Eligible property owners can receive reimbursable funding for all or a portion of the cost. Funds will be distributed to Town-approved contractors, only after approved costs have been incurred and property owners submit necessary documentation. The program will operate until 2026 on a first-come, first-served basis until funds are exhausted.

## **Eligibility Requirements**

- Property must be located within the town limits of the Town of Warrenton.
- Applicant must be the owner of a home or structure currently relying on a private septic system.
- Property is within 300 linear feet of an existing public sewer line.

## **Application Review Process**

Applications will be accepted on a first-come/first-serve basis until funds are exhausted or by June 1, 2026. The Town has designated RK&K to review and approve completed applications. A site visit may be required if deemed necessary to proceed.
